STATEMENT OF WORK (SOW)

United States District Court is soliciting a Request for Quotations (RFQ), for the selected contractor to provide pricing for:

Audio/Visual Cabling Upgrade of Courtroom 18A

SCOPE OF WORK:

AV Cabling Installation – Provide all labor & materials for the installation of:

- (4) Category 6A shielded cables to Judge location
- (4) Category 6A shielded cables to CRD location
- (3) Category 6A shielded cables to Court Reporter location
- (2) Category 6A shielded cables to Law Clerk location
- (13) Category 6A shielded cables to Plaintiff Table location
- (17) Category 6A shielded cables to Defense location
- (12) Category 6A shielded cables to Jury location
- (4) Category 6A shielded cables to Gallery location
- (3) Category 6A shielded cables to ECRO location
- (8) Category 6A shielded cables to Camera location
- (5) Category 6A shielded cables to Podium location
- (4) Category 6A shielded cables to Floor boxes
- (2) Category 6A shielded cables to Interpreter location

A total of (81) Category 6A shielded cables to be installed in courtroom 18A

In addition, provide all labor & materials for the installation of:

- (2) 48 Port Patch Panels in existing AV Equipment racks
- Patch cords at existing AV Equipment rack
- Patch cords at device end of added cabling

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:

- Terminate, label, & test all cabling according to TIA/EIA/ANSI, industry, & U.S. District Court standards
- Provide cabling test results & as-built drawings at the completion of project in electronic & paper form
- One-year warranty from substantial completion on workmanship & manufacturer's warranty
- Prevailing wages apply

Wage Rate Determination:

Due to the estimated cost of this procurement, wage determinations will be necessary pursuant to the Davis-Bacon Act and/or the Service Contract Act as determined by the Department of Labor.

Please see www.wdol.gov for worker benefits under the Service Contract Act.

- Contractor parking expenses must be included in proposal
- Contractor must be self-insured

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Contractor is encouraged to schedule a pre-proposal walk-through with Tony Duck
- Project work is estimated to begin **June 1, 2023**
- All work shall be performed during normal business hours
- Submitted proposal must be valid a minimum of 30 days from the Response Due Date

CONTRACTOR EXCLUSIONS / COURT PROVIDED ADDITIONS:

- Electrical rough-in to exclude back boxes, conduit, junction box, wall field raceway & power at head-end
- Fire Rated plywood in IDF rooms to be provided & installed by others
- Code upgrades to existing equipment
- Roof penetrations & patching
- Removal or reinstallation of sheetrock for electrical rough-in

- Painting & patching of existing surfaces
- Temporary power & lighting

****CONSIDERATIONS****

- Work will be conducted at a secure federal building – all contractor staff will need to be screened (similar to TSA airport screening) upon entry & escorted by a Court employee while on the premises
- Due to the nature of a federal courthouse, proper decorum is expected
- Access to Judiciary IT networks will be provided by Court employee as needed
