DISPOSITIVE MOTION CUTOFF - 105-DAY RULE

Judge Robart sets the dispositive motion cutoff 105 days prior to the trial date. This allows the parties 30 days to brief the motion; the court 45 days to decide the motion; and the parties 30 days after receiving the ruling to prepare for trial, if necessary. Judge Robart will not modify this schedule unless the parties set forth an extraordinary basis for modifying the scheduling order to decrease the period between the dispositive motion cutoff and the trial date to less than 105 days.
