The Judicial Conference also approved language clarifying the definitions of daily, hourly and realtime transcripts. The new language removes references to "adjournment" and "unusual circumstances" for tolling delivery time. Now, the definitions for all transcript categories and rates are applicable based on when a transcript is ordered from the court reporter, not when the underlying proceeding ended.

The term "Daily Transcript" is a transcript to be delivered on the calendar day following receipt of the order (regardless of whether that calendar day is a weekend or holiday) prior to the normal opening hour of the clerk's office.

The term "Hourly Transcript" is a transcript of proceedings to be delivered within two (2) hours from receipt of the order.

The term "Realtime Transcript" is a draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following receipt of the order.
